**Position Title: Field Inspector**  
**Department: Assisted Housing**

### **SUMMARY:**

Under the direction of the Inspections Supervisor the Field Inspector is responsible for the inspections of dwellings in the Assisted Housing Programs for compliance of Housing Quality Standards (HQS). The Field Inspector also performs a variety of other related management and administrative tasks.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

*The below statements are intended to describe the general nature and scope of work being performed by this position. This is not a complete listing of all responsibilities, duties and/or skills required. Other duties may be assigned.*

1. Performs initial inspections of units for compliance with Housing Quality Standards (HQS).
2. Schedules annual re-certification inspections on a monthly basis.
3. Performs annual re-certification inspections.
4. Performs pre-contract inspections for Project Based Vouchers.
5. Contacts and interacts with existing landlords.
6. Process annual rent increase requests.
7. Performs special inspections as needed.
8. Process abatements, holds and releases as needed.
9. Conducts rent reasonableness surveys.
10. Attends meetings and training as needed.
11. Prepares inspection reports.
12. Conducts utility checks.

Perform other related duties as assigned and/or required.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

*To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and /or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.*

- Knowledge of building maintenance and construction methods and materials.

### **EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:**

High school graduate or equivalent. Three (3) years' experience in residential and multi-family building maintenance and inspections or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Housing Quality Standard Training and Lead Based Paint Visual Training Assessment must be completed within 1 year of hire.

Valid Texas driver's license, or obtain one within 30 days of hire, Eligible for coverage under FWHS fleet auto insurance policy
